The long awaited book about the first 100 years of the Strathaven Scouts is about to be published. Entitled '**Strathaven Scouts - A Centenary History**' it is a hard bound and high quality production of 256 pages and includes around 200 photographs of Strathaven Scouting events and activities from 1908 until the present

It boasts a foreword in the form of a letter of congratulation from the Chief Scout, Bear Grylls, together with his signed photograph.

The wrap around cover features the Group's oldest photograph – showing the Strathaven Scouts on the bridge they built over the Pomillon in 1911.

It is planned to have the official launch of the book at the FOSS Annual General Meeting on Tuesday 3rd December 2013 and later that week the Explorer Scouts will build a replica of the 1911 bridge over the river in the Allison Green weather and river level permitting.

The cost of the book will be £14.99. Any profits made from its sales will be directed to a good cause sponsored by the Scout Group – still to be determined. 300 copies have been ordered initially.
